Biking the Trails

Visit: Free Heel and Wheel for age appropriate trails and rentals. A good choice with kids is the riverside trail. The trail is relatively flat and you can have a picnic lunch along the Madison River.

Hiking

Whits Lake Trail, #75 is a short hike through fir trees and an open area at the lower lake that then climbs and gains elevation to an upper lake. The upper lake has lily pads and it is common to see osprey. Round trip is two miles and don't forget to bring your bear spray.
